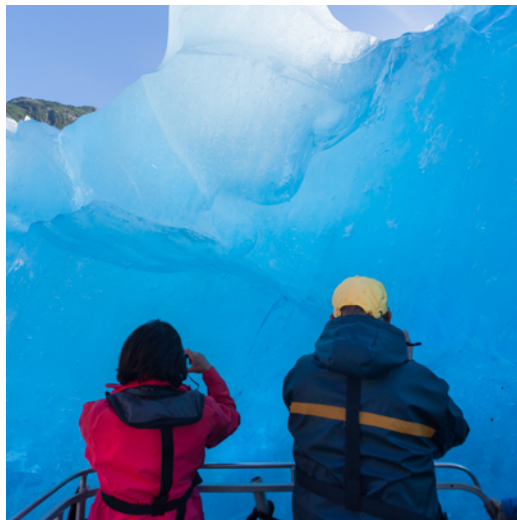

VENTURE TO EXTRAORDINARY DESTINATIONS

SITKA, AK

Sitka is a place of many traditions. You'll immediately recognize the distinctive Russian domes and assume this city has Russian origins. You'd be right, but the heart of Sitka has been Tlingit for more than 10,000 years. For even longer, it has been home to the wild creatures who make Alaska exceptional.

SHORESIDE DISCOVERIES:

Sitka Sound Science Center & Fortress of the Bear

Long before Russian settlers and even Tlingit fishing villages, Sitka was home to an abundant ecosystem perfect for the likes of the salmon and the great brown bears Alaska is known for. On this excursion, you will gain a personal connection to the local wildlife. At the Sitka Sound Science Center, marvel at interactive exhibits that make you feel like you've explored the ocean depths. Get within 25 feet of bears at Fortress of the Bear, where naturalists share how their rescues provide the bears with long, healthy lives.



KAKE (FREDERICK SOUND), AK

Centrally located in the state's panhandle at the tip of Kupreanof Island along Frederick Sound, amid blue-gray seas and dense forested lands, this village has been inhabited by the Kake tribe for thousands of years. A towering totem pole, the largest carved from a single tree, stands sentinel over the ancient village.

SHORESIDE DISCOVERIES:

Included Tlingit Cultural Tour

Experience the Tlingit culture as you explore Kake. Residents offer warm welcomes and invite you to participate in their long-standing traditions. A short walk from the dock is the tribal community hall, where a carving or weaving demonstration will take place. Then, step onto the dancefloor where locals will perform. The journey continues to Kake's most well-known attraction. Gaze upon the world's largest one-tree totem as Tlingit legends are told by your local guide.

Discover Five Finger Lighthouse

Whale specialists from this premier whale research center will join us onboard. Using unique hydrophone technology, we'll listen to for the majestic sound of humpback whales as they engage in bubble-net feeding.

TRACY ARM & ENDICOTT ARM, AK

Tracy Arm is oft-considered the most majestic of all the Alaskan fjords. The term fjord means a long, narrow deep-water inlet surrounded by towering cliffs and the Tracy Arm Fjord is a stunning example.

The Endicott Arm is part of the Tracy Arm-Fjords Terror Wilderness area. While the Endicott fjord has fewer twists and turns than the Tracy fjord, it extends over 30 miles long and makes up for it with the spectacular Dawes Glacier at its head – a very active glacier producing lots of new icebergs.

EXPEDITION ADVENTURE:

Included Experience

There is no better place than Tracy and Endicott arms to view how ice can transform the landscape. As you explore by kayaks and Zodiacs led by our expedition team, look for mountain goats, harbor seals and the rare harbor porpoise. The shoreline is one of the best places to view black bears as they forage. As we transit the fjords, look for examples of plant succession and glacial geology. If you stay onboard, there are lectures and interactive science demonstrations.

The modern *Ocean Victory* with its sleek profile is a marked contrast to the working boats of Alaska's largest home-based halibut fleet, who call this shallow harbor home. American Queen Voyages guests are among the privileged few to be in this authentic Alaskan village for a full day of exploration.

SHORESIDE DISCOVERIES:

Included Sons of Norway Experience

Experience the culture and cuisine of Norway at the historic Sons of Norway Hall in downtown Petersburg, built 1912. The hall is the center of the community, hosting receptions, parties, socials, and more. Enjoy a Norwegian snack as you watch the Leikkaring Dancers perform traditional dances, then join in on the fun.

LeConte Glacier by Jetboat

Set out on a journey of discovery as you visit North America's southernmost tidewater glacier. The natural landscape and stunning scenery of Alaska provide experiences like no other. Climb aboard the jet boat and glide through LeConte Bay — known for its bright blue icebergs, lively wildlife, and of course, LeConte Glacier. Get an up-close look at the giant glacier and discover the science behind the frozen mass and its impact on the ecosystem.

WATERFALL COAST (GUT BAY), AK

EXPEDITION ADVENTURE:

Included Experience

Today's challenge is to keep track of the waterfalls you'll encounter along Baranof Island's eastern shore, the little-known "waterfall coast." Some trickle, some thunder, some simply splash merrily to the sea. Exploration is the order of the day, and you choose your point of view – from any of *Ocean Victory's* observation perspectives. Explore the tucked-away bays and salt chunks at the very foot of sheer mountains and cliffs by Zodiacs or kayak led by our team of naturalists. Watch for seals, deer, a brown bear and tidepools ready to reveal their secret treasures.



WRANGELL, AK

Explore the dramatic Stikine River – what the Tlingit people call "the Great River." Spend a full day in this picturesque town as you are welcomed by the native Alaskans whose ancestors have lived on this island for thousands of years. They open their tribal home, their culture, and their magnificent river for your exploration. Take home your own petroglyph rubbing to remember your time among more than 40 ancient petroglyphs on the 8,000-year-old site of Petroglyph Beach.

SHORESIDE DISCOVERIES:

Jet Boat Journey on the Stikine River

Climb aboard a covered and heated jet boat for an exhilarating ride along the Stikine River. The river stretches for more than 300 miles through the forest and has a rich history that dates to the settlement of the Tlingit. Enjoy thoughtful narration from your local guide as you are lead to Shakes Lake, where you can view the ancient ice formations of Shakes Glacier.

Included Island Heritage Discovery Tour

Discover the history of Wrangell through the lens of its first people, the Tlingit. On this journey, you will see how their culture continues to thrive as a guest at Chief Shakes Tribal House. Enter the house, where each wooden plank was carved by traditional methods, then step into the gold rush era at the Wrangell Museum. Informative exhibits highlight events that led to establishment of the town. While Wrangell began to boom, it is the third-oldest city in Alaska. At Petroglyph Beach, uncover the mysteries of ancient rock carvings as you comb through the sand.



MISTY FJORDS, AK

Soaring granite cliffs 50 to 70 million years old and ancient glaciers that scrubbed deep troughs through this wilderness created the geological wonder that is Misty Fjords National Monument Wilderness. New Eddystone Rock is an immense basalt pillar rising from the sea left as a testament to long-ago volcanic activity.

EXPEDITION ADVENTURE:

Included Experience

Spend the day exploring the shoreline with our zodiacs or kayaks for a true closeup wilderness experience. Our team of marine biologists from California Polytechnic State University will join to for a hands-on science experience. Look for humpback whales, orcas, sea lions, bears, wolves, moose, and hundreds of species of sea and shorebirds.

KETCHIKAN, AK

The totem poles of Ketchikan and Saxman formally greet visitors to Alaska's southernmost city. Standing tall and noble, each hand-carved symbol tells a silent story. The locals with their wide, genuine smiles are sure to welcome you more warmly to the only settlement of indigenous Tsimshian people in the United States.

SHORESIDE DISCOVERIES:

Included City Highlights Tour

Discover Ketchikan from the comfort of our motorcoach. As you drive along the bustling waterfront, you'll see some colorful landmarks in the downtown and Ward Cove areas. Behold the lush city park, stunning Ketchikan Creek and visit the Saxman Totem Park — a famous photo opportunity. Saxman Totem Park features 25 totems which are authentic replicas of those left in abandoned villages. Our expert guide will even regale you with tales of historic Creek Street — Ketchikan's "Red Light" district — one of the city's most popular attractions.

METLAKATLA, AK

This ocean seaport provides quality cultural, educational, and hands-on experiences for the Metlakatla Indian Community and other Alaskan natives. It's the only settlement in the United States where you can explore true Tsimshian culture in their native island. Visit the traditional Metlakatla Longhouse that celebrates the Tsimshian way of life.

SHORESIDE DISCOVERIES:

Walking Town Tour & Totem Pole Journey

The Totem Exploration Journey is a path that will guide you to 14 of the standing totem Poles in Metlakatla and featured along the path are several historical & cultural Points of Interest, including the William Duncan Memorial Church, the Metlakatla Indian Community Longhouse, and the Artist Village. End your time ashore at our community Long House where a presentation about the traditional building will take place along with a dance performance by a traditional Tsimshian dance group.

FIORDLAND (KYNOKH INLET), BC

These narrow, finger-like inlets or “fiords” extend into the mainland, creating miles of shoreline and bringing seawater deep into the heartland of the steep, coastal mountains. Two such fiords, Kynoch and Mussel, comprise the major portion of the Fiordland Conservancy. Each features splendid waterfalls cascading down massive granite cliffs.

Scenic Cruising

With our exclusive access to Kynoch inlet, you'll get to see unique coastal marine life in an area accessible only by sea. Where you are in the expansive observation lounge, on deck or on the one-of-a-kind viewing platform, keep your eye out for whales, dolphins, bears and many more charismatic species. Join our team of marine biologists from California Polytechnic State University and our scientists in a workshop for a hands-on science experience.

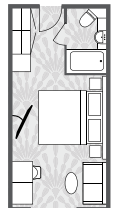


STATEROOM WITH FRENCH VERANDA
